

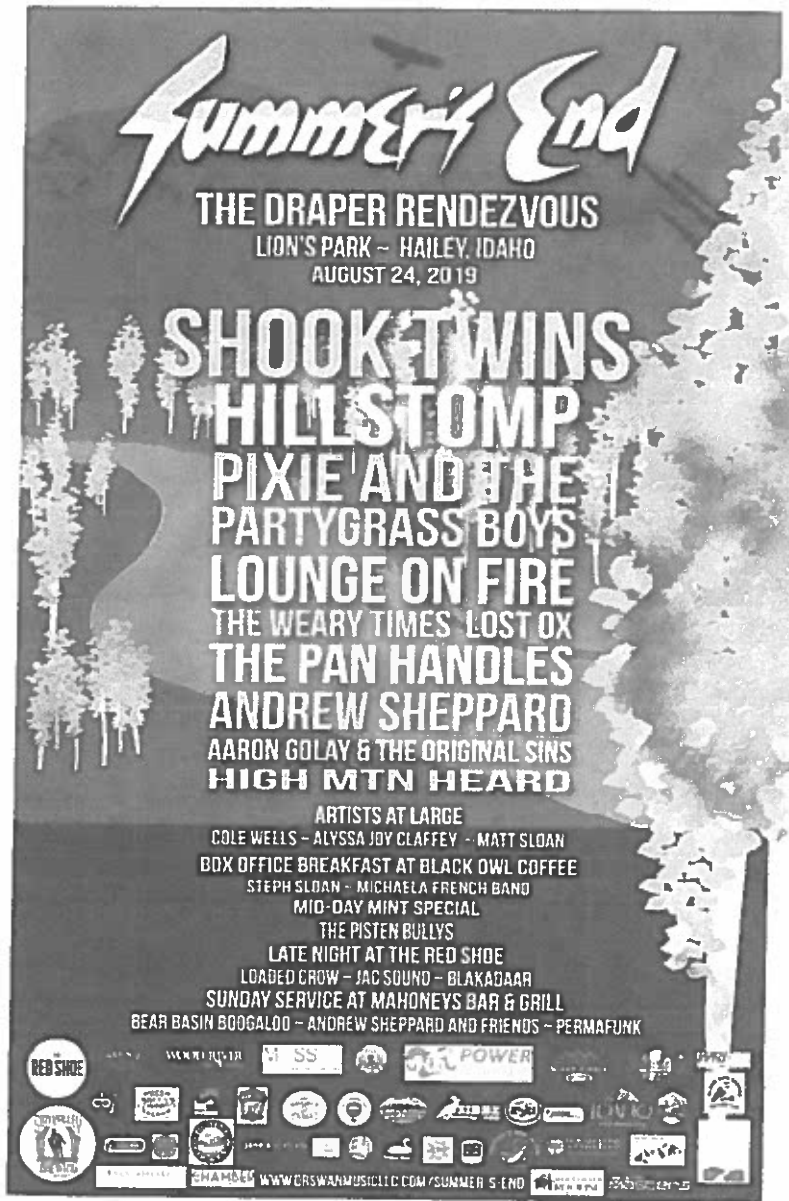

Dear Smoking Plan for Summer's End ~ The Draper Rendezvous and to whom it may concern,
In this letter involves the Fire / Security Plan for The Second Annual Summer's End ~ The Draper Rendezvous (Music Festival Proposal at Lion's Park August 22nd, 2020) I am trying to bring a music festival to the Wood River Valley like the Northern Rockies Music Festival. Here is the fire / safety / security plan.

Security Plan ~ Security will be ran through Premier Security Services. 5 security guards are hired with owner of company will attend event. Also, a volunteer crew will work as security also. There are 8 gates that will be covered by volunteers in the following areas:

1. River and Croy Creek Road
2. Croy Creek Road and Lion's Park Entrance
3. Main entrance gate (ticket checking gate)
4. Pavilion gate
5. Vendor gate
6. Backstage gate
7. Gates from backstage to venue
8. All emergency exits and surrounding festival grounds premises.

The 5 security guards will sweep the festival grounds throughout the event. Volunteers will make sure general public is safe and sound along with security (Volunteers ran by volunteer / security company). A security / volunteer tent will be available at the event for volunteers and people to check in to give any notifications or volunteers checking in to their volunteer time for the festival.

Fire Plan ~ 2 Fire chiefs / marshals on duty in case of emergency. 8 fire extinguishers on site in multiple locations (see map). 5 gates for emergency exits in case of fire. There is a pathway for firetrucks to get in and out of Lion's park if fire starts. Draper Preserve trail to the back side of Hailey will be another emergency exit if needed but in hopes I plan on no fires. There will be a fire tent next to medical tent and backstage tents if there is needing assistance.

SMOKING RULE ~ DrSwanMusic would like to try NO Smoking at event. For people whom can't live and function without smoking, I / DrSwanMusic, plan on making 2 smoking sections (one by bathrooms and one in parking lot). Will EMPHASISE as much as possible that the community DOESN'T NEED A FIRE. Volunteers will be structured on how to direct people politely to disregard smoking or go to smoking section. SAFETY AND NO FIRES IS PRIORITY.

Safety Plan ~ The number 1 priority with Summer's End is to have a safe end of summer community event. Safety is my number 1 concern and fires. I want this festival to last 40 years. To last 40 years each year the festival runs it must be completely safe to community, general public, and property of event. Safe controlled environment is my number one concern due to people not using common sense these days. I hope that there are no accidents, no fires, and everything is controlled and operated smoothly, and "Summer's End" and keep bringing music to the Wood River Valley in a safely manner. There will be a medical EMT tent with a licensed EMT (possibly 2 to cover all ends) in case of medical emergencies. The ambulance will have a clear path to come through to the festival and get out quickly if in case of injury or emergency that the ambulance is needed.

Parking / Traffic Control / Encroachment Plan for Summer's End:

Parking for Summer's End ~ The Draper Rendezvous will be distributed in the parking lot of Lion's Park and throughout Hailey, Idaho.

Lion's Park Parking ~ Approximately 20 – 60 parking spots with EMT / Fire drive through in case of emergency. Parking is designated for staff of the event (artists, vendors, staff of DrSwanMusic & Summer's End, disabled, and a very small parking selection (to be determined). Parking will be sectioned off by each section to maintain flow of artists bringing gear, vendors needing more food, etc.

Croy Creek Road / Bullion Road (Surroundings of Lion's and Hop Porter Park) ~

DrSwanMusic will be giving tickets to the Hop Porter Park / Lion's Park neighborhoods for the event to please the neighborhood of the park, and to also accommodate some of the general public. Some people may park their cars at neighborly houses if asked the owner of the house.

River Street ~ Parking can be used also along River street with the Park and Ride.

Kings / Albertsons / Parking Lot next to McDonalds ~ Parking can be used here as well. DrSwanMusic is planning on hiring a shuttle bus and coordinating with land and businesses that can bring people to the festival from these places to Lion's Park.

Hailey, Idaho Miscellaneous Parking ~ Suggesting through promotion to carpool to event and coordinate with others to compromise problems with cluster parking.

Bullion + River Street – Flagger and a tent will be along the side of the street to direct traffic through Croy Canyon / Summer's end.

Traffic Control Plan for Summer's End:

All Staff, Artists, Vendors, Security, and any other personnel that is involved with Summer's Ends Operations will have vehicle passes mailed to them before the event. All other parking needed for disabled and people whom paid for the parking passes that are available (very select assortment of 5 to 10 parking passes). Pathway for event participants down Croy Creek Road / Bullion Street on north side of street, from River Street to the festival grounds (Lion's Park) will have a roped off pathway not blocking people's driveways and homes. Volunteered Security will watch these pathways for safety. Shuttle services mentioned in parking plan will help traffic control. One tent will be at the cross sections of River Street and Croy Creek Road with volunteers directing traffic and general attendance crowds going through. Checking vehicle passes and ensuring Croy Canyon citizens can drive out to their residence homes. Another tent at entrance for Lion's park help with traffic and ensure everyone whom is possible to park in Lion's Park is part of Summer's End Crew & Staff. Signs will be distributed for general attendance throughout the city of Hailey for direction and guidance.

Smoking Plan (To Whom It May Concern),

Priorities are safety, music, and community gathering. Safety is biggest concern with hopes of no fires. Community event with no medical and emergency problems.
